Navsarjan has a strong presence in the city of Surat, working extensively across 52 slum communities. As part of their efforts, they have established 32 Mahila Mandals (women's collectives) within these communities. Trained and mobilized around 352 women volunteers from the slums. The Mahila Mandal members regularly visit local authorities to discuss problems and issues faced by the community. They also visit schools to monitor attendance and help reduce dropout rates. Navsarjan and the Mahila Mandal members work together to help community members access and avail benefits from various government welfare schemes.
