

Save the environment The environment will save our lives and future



Save the environment and it will save lives and future - World Environment Day Celebration



65 women from the women's Association of Tadkeshwar, Indiranagar, Rasulabad, Batliboy areas celebrated World Environment Day in coordination with the officers of Surat Municipal Corporation. The officers of Surat Municipal Corporation explained to the women about the impact of plastic use on our lives and how dangerous its use is, after that the women and the officers jointly undertook a cleaning campaign.





Navsarjan organized specialized adolescent camps for 39 teenage girls from Hayatnagar and Althan, focusing on empowering them through education on essential topics such as menstruation, physical and mental health, education, and marriage. The camps emphasized the importance of nutrition, hygiene, and exercise for overall well-being. Participants engaged in discussions about menstruation—its nature, process, and significance—as well as the importance of maintaining both physical and mental health. They also explored the value of education and career planning, responsible decision-making and practical tips for leading fulfilling lives. To enhance understanding, information was supplemented with visual aids such as posters. The girls showed great enthusiasm for the knowledge they gained, much of which was new to them. Mothers expressed their gratitude, noting the valuable insights their daughters acquired and encouraged the continuation of such camps in the future.

Legal Awareness Camp: Empowering Society through Legal Empowerment

Navsarjan organized a legal awareness camp aimed at educating people about the legal system and citizens' rights. The camps were held in Swami Vivekananda, Indiranagar and Shivshakti, with a total of 82 participants.

During the camp, a lawyer discussed what legal aid is and how to access it, as well as House legal documents and rental agreement. Participants gained more information about the legal system Importance of house documents and rental agreement, becoming more aware and empowered.







Navchetna organized a meeting attended by 31 participants. During this meeting, the members viewed the film "Bharat Ek Shodh" Episode 45, titled "Mahatma Phule," which centers on Mahatma Phule, his contributions as a social reformer, and his battle against caste discrimination in India. The episode emphasizes his initiatives to educate women and lower castes, thereby challenging the entrenched social hierarchy of that era.

The discussion included how Navchetna members could assist underprivileged individuals in gaining greater access to the benefits offered by Navsarjan's Legal Advice Center, and suggestions from the members were solicited.

A conversation took place with the members concerning the proposal to expand the number of government schools for grades 9, 10, 11, and 12 in Surat city, as well as to increase the number of teachers in proportion to the student

population in government schools.


Relief Operation – Kamrunagar

Due to the significant rainfall in Kamrunagar, specifically in the Limbayat area, flooding occurred as the water from the adjacent Mithi creek overflowed. In this challenging circumstance, local leaders and members of the Mahila Mandal convened with the chief of the ward office to organize food provisions for the affected residents. The majority individuals in this locality are employed in the nearby market. Provisions were made to supply for approximately food residents of this area.








Survey of children in the area

A survey of children was conducted in 5 areas at the beginning of the new academic session in June. A total of 637 children were surveyed, including 435 for tuition classes, 122 for kindergarten, 37 girls/sisters for sewing classes and 43 children for computer classes.
