Ration Zone Visit – Knowledge is our strength

A total of 72 women from 19 areas visited the Bhestan Ration Zone. The staff explained the different forms used in the ration department and provided information about the required documents.

Cleaning Campaign - A Step towards Cleanliness



The Mahila Mandal of Rasulabad and Tadkeshwar, along with the Surat Municipal Corporation, conducted a joint cleaning campaign. Eleven members, together with local residents, cleaned their area and spread awareness about avoiding litter.























Teachers' Day was celebrated at the Navsarjan-run Elite Classes with 251 children, 44 parents, and 28 women's group members. On this occasion, children became teachers for a day and taught their peers. They participated with great enthusiasm.



Committee Meeting – Safe Environment for Employees









On 27 September 2025, Navsarjan hosted a meeting of the Anti-Sexual Harassment Committee and the Child Protection Committee. The committee interacted personally with female employees to understand their concerns. Staff were also briefed on the Sexual Harassment Act and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO). A total of 19 staff members participated.



Navchetna Member Meeting – Considerations for Guiding Children's Art

During the meeting with 29 Navchetna members, discussions were held on planning Children's Day celebrations. The focus was on encouraging children's hidden talents and nurturing their dreams.





Health Check-up Camp – Healthy Life, Happy Life







Navsarjan organized a health check-up and awareness camp for 94 children. Live demonstrations highlighted healthy eating, hygiene, limited mobile use, and the dangers of addiction. Children underwent health check-ups and were given necessary medicines.

Kidney Awareness Camp – Early Detection, Better Protection



In Marutinagar, a kidney awareness camp was held with 39 participants. Tests revealed high BP in 6 people and high sugar in 3 women, who were referred for treatment. A 12-year-old child diagnosed with kidney failure has begun treatment.

Adolescent Girls' Camp – Health and Wellness

held Camps were in Patelnagar, Hegdewad, and Panchsheelnagar 95 for adolescent girls. **Topics** included menstruation, nutrition, education, marriage, and career planning. Posters discussions enriched and learning. Mothers encouraged more such camps in the future.







Legal Awareness Camp – Empowering Citizens with Knowledge

In Gautamnagar, 17 people attended a legal awareness camp. A lawyer explained how to access legal aid, the importance of property documents, and the validity of rental agreements.

Discussion with Children – Awareness is our Strength











On 29 September 2025, 50 children from Surat slums engaged in discussions on gender equality, values, and the Indian Constitution. Their views were heard and they were made aware of these important issues.
