On 20th November 2024, Fr. Francis Bosco, Director of Don Bosco for Migrants, visited Navsarjan Xavier Cell for Human Development, and slum areas of Surat city along with Fr. Melwin Dsa SJ, Mr. Sunil, and Mr. Sarad from Aajeevika NGO to understand the vital work being carried out by the Pravasi Shramik Suraksha Manch (PSSM). His visit aimed to evaluate the conditions of migrant workers, particularly in the power loom industry.



Visit of Fr. Francis Bosco, Director of Don Bosco for Migrants, to Navsarjan and Surat Slums

Fr. Bosco visited the power loom sector at Ved Road (Fulwadi), where he observed their challenging situation, where they have limited access to adequate shelter and communal dining areas. This visit helped him gain a deeper understanding of the labourers' daily struggles and living conditions.

Visited the Din-Dayal Shelter Home in Morabhagal Circle, runs by Prayas NGO a safe haven for migrant workers in Surat. The NGO entrusted with the task of providing crucial identification cards to migrant workers. These include the Abha Card, Ayushman Card, e-Shram Card, and e-Nirman Card, which are necessary for accessing government benefits and health services.

Through this visit, Fr. Bosco was able to gather comprehensive information about the migrant workers; plight in Surat and acknowledge the significant role of organizations like Navsarjan, PSSM, and Prayas NGO in advocating for the rights and welfare of these vulnerable groups.
